New Policy Regarding Waived Metrorail Fees during Downtown Events

In October 2009, Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) transitioned to a new Automated Fare Collection System known as the EASY Card. To access Metrorail, riders must now use an EASY Card or EASY Ticket to pay their fare by tapping it on the station faregates. To avoid long lines, MDT encourages all event goers to purchase an EASY Card or EASY Ticket prior to the day of the race. Both are available at EASY Card vending machines located at all Metrorail stations.

Through Team Footworks, MDT is will be offering a special 1-Day Pass for those participating in the upcoming Mercedes-Benz Corporate Run. The 1-Day Pass, which is regularly sold for \$5, will be loaded on an EASY Ticket and sold at the discounted rate of \$2 for event participants. This discounted pass will be available only at Team Footworks.

Transit services extended for Corporate Run participants

MDT will provide additional Metrorail and Metromover service to event goers attending the 2010 Mercedes-Benz Corporate Run on Thursday, April 29th, 2009.

Metrorail

Metrorail service will be provided every 15 minutes starting at 6 p.m. until 10 p.m. Service will be adjusted to normal weekday service after the event until closing.

Metromover

Additional Metromover service will be provided during the event. Service will be adjusted to normal weekday service after the event.
